ABOUT THE PRODUCT

Kentucky Bluegrass is a cool climate grass with a deep green leaf, particularly throughout winter. Featuring an excellent resistance to frost, it has non-aggressive regenerative properties via underground runners called rhizomes, and is the ideal lawn for yards with low garden beds. Kentucky Bluegrass can be integrated well with other grass types, such as fescue and ryegrass, and comes in both instant and seeded form.

AFTERCARE

Establishing

- Kentucky Bluegrass can be planted all year round but does not like being planted in very hot conditions
- A thorough soaking with water straight after installation
- Will need frequent deep watering until well established
- The first mow can be undertaken once your turf has established and the root system can no longer be lifted from the ground

Mowing

- Regular weekly mowing is recommended during the growing season; once a week in cooler months, then every 2-4 weeks in other months (or when necessary, depending on growth and watering habits).
- The recommended optimal length is 5 - 7cm. If in a shady position, it should be kept longer at all times.
- When mowing, only take 1/3 off the leaf at one time

Watering

- Once established, water weekly or as necessary. Depending on the weather. 2-4 deep waters per week in the heat of summer is needed. Use the colour of the lawn as guidance.

Fertilising

- Fertilise 3-4 times over the growing season (Autumn to Spring) using a fertiliser with a higher Nitrogen content, such as Akers of Lawn Organic Based Fertiliser.
