 <p>When the eggs hatch, the larvae or grubs emerge that then feed on the grass roots. It is when large numbers of these eggs hatch that it is a serious problem for some lawns.</p>	<p><b><u>Type</u></b></p> <p><b>African Black Beetle</b></p> <p>A shiny jet black scarab soil dwelling pest, look similar to a cockroach.
