Common Lawn Pests



When the eggs hatch, the larvae or grubs emerge that then feed on the grass roots. It is when large numbers of these eggs hatch that it is a serious problem for some lawns.

Type

African Black Beetle

A shiny jet black scarab soil dwelling pest, look similar to a cockroach. Its larvae are white/creamy, soft bodied curl grubs.

The most active time of the year for this beetle is during Spring and Summer.

Each female can lay up to 80 eggs!
