Type

Oxalis Weed
 Appears with different colour flowers.
 Appears like a miniature clover plant.
 When seed pods mature, they dry out and explode causing the seed to spread.

All Year Round

These weeds look similar to Clover, Trefoils, Sour Sobs and Medics.

Often mistaken for clover and sour sobs, sour sobs have black dots on their leaves, and clover has white circular shape on the leaves.

Bow and Arrow safe to use on Zoysia, Kikuyu, Buffalo and Couch grasses. – Post Emergent

Barricade - which is suitable for use on Zoysia, Kikuyu, Buffalo and Couch grasses. – Post Emergent

Rosette forming with parallel leaf venation. Flowers singularly on tip of lengthy stem.

Often mistaken for clover and oxalis, sour sobs have little black spots on their leaves.

Type

Sour Sobs

Soursobs are regularly confused with clover due to their very similar leaf appearance. Soursobs spread with clover-like leaves along the ground, producing flowers with 5 petals and have a long white tuberous root. One of the most important things to do is to try and target Soursob before it flowers. It is when it is flowering that the bulbils are growing and creating more plants.

June to October

Products To Use

Completely eradicating Soursobs from your lawn will take a bit of time and effort. Unlike many other weeds, it is not recommended to remove them by hand, as the bulbils will break off and continue to grow beneath the soil allowing it to reappear. There are also no selective herbicides readily available for domestic lawns that will target the Soursobs, so you will need to take a few other steps to try and remove it. Mowing the tops off regularly will weaken the plant helping your grass to overcome the infestation. Bulb exhaustion occurs just before flowering, so this is the perfect time to implement your mowing and non-selective herbicide application, when the plant is weak. This is the only stage that physical removal will be an option, by digging up under the plant and removing the soil around it as well.

Zero Ultra Tough – Spot spray individual weeds very carefully.

Application 2-3 times, in between mowing the weed heads regularly will help deplete the bulb.

Organic fertilizing monthly in the flowering months will also help your lawn.
