ABOUT THE PRODUCT

Sir Grange has dark green, fine blades that give it a high shade tolerance and low maintenance, making for a very versatile turf. Originally developed for golf courses, Sir Grange responds well to wear and tear and Australian weather. This turf requires less mowing, less water and less time, making it perfect for busy households.

AFTERCARE

Establishing

- Sir Grange is an extremely slow growing lawn and can take some extended time to fully establish
- Check establishment by gently lifting the corner of your turf

Mowing

- Once fully established you can give your lawn its first gentle trim, taking just the tips off
- Only remove 1/3 of the leaf blade each time
- Avoid mowing unless necessary during the cooler months
- Stop cutting in April until mid-September (for the duration of winter)

Watering

- Weeks 1 - 3: Water 2 - 3 times per day, but don't flood it - short 10 minute waters are best. If you have sub surface irrigation you must water from above until the roots have established
- Weeks 4 - 5: Water once a day for 45 minutes
- Weeks 5 - 8: Continue to water deeply, approximately 60 minutes every 3 days
- Once established, water only when the grass appears to be dry
- Minimise irrigation during winter to avoid waterlog

Fertilising

- Fertilise 6 to 8 weeks after installation, and at the beginning of spring
- Requires 1/3 of the fertiliser used on other turf varieties
